### Where is it ...??

In the centre of Gloucester, half a mile from the Docks, heading out of the City Centre on the Bristol Road.

### What is it ...??

Individual or team events.

Endurance Go-Karting is an exhilarating team event. Regular driver changes and a fuel stop keep the team involved with the action. Every team can see a lap-by-lap result throughout the event.

### No previous experience necessary!!

Whether you are a complete novice without even a driving licence or a would-be Lewis Hamilton – anyone can do it!

### How it runs.....

Endurance Go-Karting: the idea is we get into balanced teams of drivers, the winning team being the one that knocks up the most laps in the time period. So whether it takes 60 seconds to do a lap or 20 seconds, it doesn't matter. There is a Podium for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> positions with prize mementos.

### How much does it cost??

Depends on the amount of interest and how long the activity lasts.  
We need a minimum of 6 teams and a maximum of 10.

### Arrive & Drive

£25 for 45 minutes or £30 for 60 minutes, each with a short break

### Sprint events for groups of 13 – 70

£35	Grand Prix	5 laps	6 heats of 5 laps	All drivers 6 laps	Top 6 drivers 8 laps

Trophies awarded to the top three drivers.

Grand Prix takes a bit less than 2 hours for 13 drivers.

### 2½ hour endurance (plus 20 mins. practice)

Minimum of 24 drivers

4 drivers in a team

£160 / team - £40 each

### 1½ hour endurance (plus 20 mins. practice)

Minimum of 18 drivers

3 drivers in a team

To run an Endurance event, we need at least 25 people – otherwise the financial liability is too high if / when people drop out.
