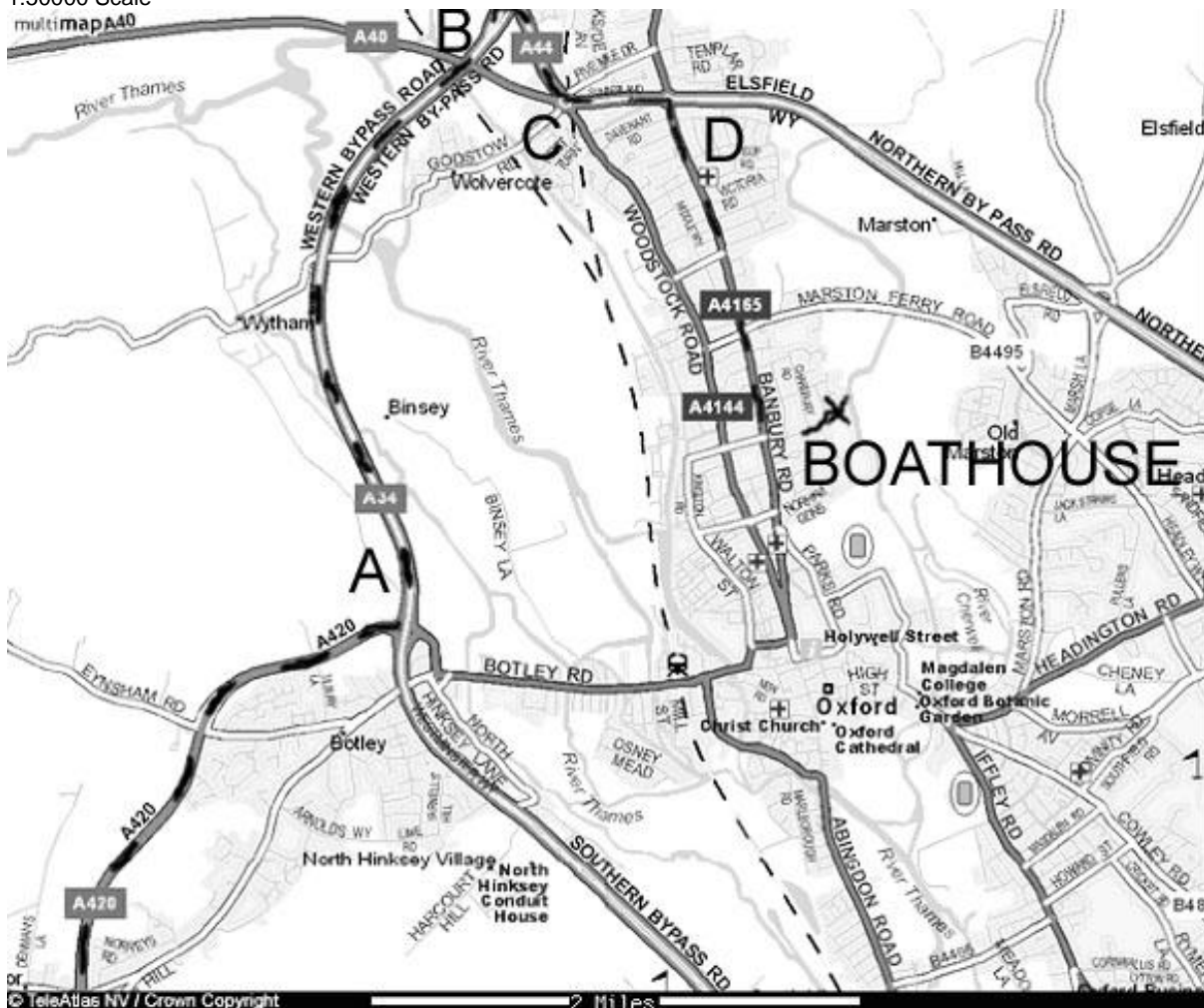


PUNTING DIRECTIONS (N.B. not easy – allow time to get lost!) – 1130~1800, 12 July 2008

Directions from Bristol:

1. Turn off M4 on the east side of Swindon and take the A420 to Oxford; beware speed cameras.
2. Turn left (north) at Oxford bypass roundabout at A. Go north 2 miles.
3. Take first turning off the bypass at B and turn sharp right onto A44. Travel 400 yards to roundabout at C.
4. Turn left at roundabout at C. Go half-a-mile east along Northern Bypass Road to roundabout at D.
5. Turn right at roundabout D. You should now be driving south along the Banbury road towards Oxford city centre.
6. Drive 1½ miles passing through the lights at Marston Ferry Road. Take the fourth turning on the left after Marston Ferry Road into Bardwell Road (it is very easy to miss).
7. At the bottom of Bardwell Road, where it bends left, turn right into the lane that leads into the Cherwell Boathouse. There is a small car park here which is likely to be full by 1100. Get in it if you can...
8. Allow LOTS of time to get there and phone the Boathouse (x01865 515978) if you get lost.
9. It is possible to leave the car at the Park'n'Ride on the north outskirts of town and get the bus in. This will take a lot longer.

Bring:

1. Some food (I like strawberries) and bottles (not all alcoholic)
 2. Towel and spare clothes, just in case; sensible shoes; rugs for lying on the grass; Frisbees, balls etc.
 3. ANYONE ELSE YOU WISH TO INVITE – make a party of it!
- DON'T bring high heels or short skirts!**

It would be **helpful** to know if you are coming and can offer anyone a lift. You don't need to book beforehand.
