a) Road and Car Park > Collision from vehicles	Participants	> Coaches to warn students about crossing the road between the car park and river bank as they could be distracted by being keen to get on/off the water. > Students told to keep the "through way" access of the car park clear as it is not unknown for cars to "speed through" especially hazardous in the dusk light.		
b) River bank > Impact injury - Falling boats from other novice canoeist groups		> When other novice groups are entering / exiting the water their is chance of "run away" boats. The Coach to ensure that their group is well clear of the "drop zone" .		
c) River bank and water > Contamination rats urine - Weils disease	Participants	> The litter collect may be unsatisfactory at times which can lead to the increased availability of food for rats. If observed take additional precautions and remind students as detailed in the <u>Weils Disease - Leptospirosis</u> information.
